

GUIDELINES FOR THE ABSTRACTS

The abstracts received that do not comply with these guidelines will be returned to authors

Margins: top: 2.5 cm; bottom: 2.5cm; left: 3cm; right: 3 cm

Font: Arial Narrow

Paragraph formatting: Left and Right Justified. No indentations

Spacing: For all the text (except affiliation): Previous: 12 pt. Back: 12 pt

For affiliation: Previous: 0 pt. Back: 0 pt

Line spacing: Simple

Communication title: size 14. In lowercase and bold.

Full scientific names, in lowercase and italics, mentioning the author and, in parentheses, the order and family

Authors: size 12. Surname, Name (initial only), in capital letters and with a numerical call in superscript for the affiliation. The different authors will be separated by semicolons.

Underline the author who will present or defend the communication.

Author affiliation: size 10. Addresses of the authors ordered according to the number of the calls in a separate line

Abstract text: size 12. Scientific names in italics. The first time they are named, they will be written in full and mentioning the author.

Maximum 300 words

Keywords: Up to 8 keywords, separated by commas. Size 12.

File name: Surname, followed by an underscore, the type of communication (Oral or Poster).

If more than one abstract is submitted, please enter a hyphen below and number the communications. Example: Lopez_poster_1.docx and Lopez_poster_2.docx
